## Exam Offerings

Sandburg, Stagg and Andrew High Schools will offer the STAMP exam to demonstrate language ability in Arabic, French, German, Hebrew, Hindi, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Mandarin (Simple or Traditional), Polish, Portuguese (Brazilian,) and Spanish and offer ALIRA to demonstrate ability in Latin. The exams will be held at each school the week of November 16, 2020 and again in March 2021. The cost of the STAMP exam is \$20 and the ALIRA is \$10.
