

PSAT/NMSQT

SUBJECT: Wednesday, October 12th - 8am start day

On Wednesday, October 12, Junior students will participate in the PSAT/NMSQT Assessment. Due to the test date, Wednesday, October 12, 2022, will be an **8:00 a.m.** start day. This will **NOT** be a late start day.

- The PSAT/NMSQT provides students with an opportunity to become familiar with the SAT testing format and also serves another purpose as the National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test. Students who say “yes” to the Student Search Service when they fill out their answer sheet will be screened for the National Merit Scholarship Program, which uses PSAT/NMSQT test results to designate students as Commended, Semifinalists, and Finalists in the fall of their senior year in high school.

ALL students will start at 8:00 a.m. There will be **NO** zero-hour classes on this day. Buses will run on the regular school day schedule. Zero-hour buses **WILL NOT** run. **All freshmen, sophomores, and seniors** will follow their regular school day schedules, including Period 2 Advisory (but **NOT** zero hour). Juniors are to resume their regular day schedules once PSAT/NMSQT testing is completed.
