WHAT IS NCAA?

- Voluntary organization that governs intercollegiate athletics.
- <u>Division I</u> 335 member schools (120 FBS, 118 FCS, 97 no football).
 - Typically larger schools.
 - •Athletics grants-in-aid available.
- <u>Division II</u> 288 member schools.
 - •Typically small to medium-sized schools, smaller athletics budgets.
 - •Athletics grants-in-aid available.
- Division III 447 member schools.
 - Typically smaller schools.
 - Grants-in-aid cannot be athletically based.

• Examples of coordinates are:

- 2.300 core-course GPA requires
 - 900 SAT or 75 sum ACT.
- 2.500 core-course GPA requires
 - 820 SAT or 68 sum ACT.
- 2.950 core-course GPA requires
 - 640 SAT or 53 sum ACT.
- A combined SAT score is calculated by adding reading and math subscores. ACT is sum of all 4 subscores.
